15.01: Purpose and Scope

540 CMR 15.00 is adopted by the Registrar pursuant to M.G.L. c. 90D, § 6 and c. 90, § 31 to establish uniform specifications for Certificates of Origin for new vehicles delivered in the Commonwealth by manufacturers to agents or franchised dealers.

15.02: Security Features

All Certificates of Origin for new vehicles sold in the Commonwealth shall contain the following security features:

(1) <u>Paper</u>:

(a) <u>Security Thread</u>, with or without watermark, or <u>Intaglio Print</u>, with or without latent image, or both.

(b) <u>Sensitized Security Paper</u>: paper that is reactive to chemicals commonly used to alter documents.

(c) <u>Non-Optical Brightener Paper</u>: paper without added optical brighteners which will not fluoresce under ultraviolet light.

(2) <u>Engraved Border</u>: a border produced from engraved artwork which shall appear on the front of the document.

(3) <u>Printing</u>: printing shall be <u>prismatic</u>, rainbow printing which is used as a deterrent to color copying; or <u>copy void pantograph</u>, with the word "VOID" appearing when the document is copied, or both.

(4) <u>Complex Colors</u>: colors which are developed by using a mixture of two or more of the primary colors (red, yellow, or blue) and black if required.

(5) <u>Erasable Florescent Background Inks</u>: ink that fluoresces under ultraviolet light and reacts to any attempt to erase in such a manner as to be immediately detectable.

(6) <u>Background Security Design</u>: a repetitious design consisting of a pattern which hinders counterfeiting efforts.

(7) <u>Micro line</u>: a line of small alpha characters in capital letters which requires a magnifying glass to read.

(8) <u>Consecutively Numbered</u>: documents that contain a number which is consecutively numbered for control purposes.

15.03: Waiver

The Registrar of Motor Vehicles reserves the right to waive any of the provisions of 540 CMR 15.00 in the public interest.
