During the 1969 legislative session, the Massachusetts General Court enacted the Comprehensive Drug Rehabilitation Act of 1969, to become effective January 1, 1970. This act was incorporated into Chapter 123 of the General Laws (section 38-55) by Chapter 888 of Acts of 1970.

The new law provides that the Division of Drug Rehabilitation administer both state-run and fee-for-services drug treatment programs. The latter may be private self-help programs that are licensed and financed by the division.

A major provision of the new law is that drug dependant individuals who have been charged with drug offenses, have the <u>right</u> to have treatment in lieu of prosecution. Section 47 provides that any individual who has been charged with a drug offense has a <u>right</u> to a medical examination to determine whether he is a drug dependant person. If the only charge against him is a drug offense, not involving the production or sale of drugs and the court finds that he is drug dependant and treatable, the criminal proceedings against him <u>must</u> be stayed at his request and he <u>must</u> be assigned to a drug treatment program. In the case of a second offender, the criminal proceedings <u>may</u> be stayed and the court <u>may</u> assign him to a drug treatment program. If, at the end of the period of the stay of criminal proceedings, it has been determined that the defendant has successfully completed his treatment program, the charges against him are dismissed.

Section 48 provides that any defendant found guilty of a non-drug offense has the right to a medical examination to determine his drug dependency and permits the court to order a drug dependant person who has been sentenced to a state penal institution of be given drug treatment while serving his sentence. In no event shall the defendant be committed pursuant to section 47 or section 48 unless the defendant consents in writing to the terms of the committment order. Section 49 provides that the court may grant probation under the condition that the defendant seek drug treatment at a facility for that purpose. In addition, the new law provides for voluntary committment for treatment and treatment for juveniles.

This report is a study of the background characteristics of those individuals committed during 1971 and 1972, who were to receive treatment in addition to incarceration (section 48). During this period, 96 drug dependant persons have been committed to M.C.I. Concord under section 48, 57 during 1971 and 39 during 1972; and 19 drug dependant persons have been committed to M.C.I. Walpole, 9 during 1971 and 10 during 1972. The tables in this report shall treat all persons committed under this section as one sample regardless of the institution to which committed. A recidivism study will be completed after a sufficient number of these commitments have been released and in the community for at least a year.
