Modifications to Long-Term Lane Closures on I-90 Eastbound and Westbound Between Beacon Street and the Prudential Center

Work zone will be shifted beginning Friday morning, June 5

BOSTON – The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing modifications to long-term lane closures on I-90 (Massachusetts Turnpike) eastbound and westbound between Beacon Street and the Prudential Center to support ongoing construction activity related to the Bowker Overpass Replacement Project.

On Thursday night, June 4, the contractor will shift the current fixed work zones along I-90 from the right low-speed lanes to the left high-speed lanes. Travel will be fully restored to the right low-speed lanes along I-90 eastbound and westbound by the following morning. The left high-speed lanes will be closed on I-90 eastbound and westbound to support fixed work zones in the vicinity of the Bowker Overpass. During this work, I-90 eastbound and westbound will maintain three vehicular travel lanes in each direction.

All lane closures will be marked with appropriate signage and traffic control devices.

Drivers should expect continued reduced speed zones, increased travel time, and potential delays when traveling through the work zone.

This work is being conducted as part of an \$84 million project to replace the Bowker Overpass bridge over I-90 in Boston.
