Ladies & Gentlemen:

In accordance with Chapter 130, Section 74A of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has determined that a portion of the shellfish growing area, the East Branch of the Westport River (David Road Relay Area - BB4.22), no longer meets the established criteria for a status of "Open to Shellfishing" due to the transplant of contaminated quahogs from the Taunton River (Permit #188320). The status of this area will be "Closed to Shellfishing" as of sunrise on Friday July 11, 2025.

Therefore, the Division of Marine Fisheries has changed the status of the below defined area to "Closed to Shellfishing" to prohibit the taking of shellfish until subsequent determination by this office reveals that the shellfish are safe for human consumption.

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 130, Section 74A, 75, and 322 CMR 7.01 (7), digging, harvesting, or collecting and/or attempting to dig, harvest, collect or the possession of shellfish from the below defined area is prohibited.

"The waters and flats of that portion of the East Branch within the area from the "NO SHELLFISHING sign at #1476 Drift Road to the western end of Big Pine Island to the southernmost end of Lower Spectacle Island continuing to the "NO SHELLFISHING" sign at #1436 Drift Road."
