Vonage Holdings Corp. ("Vonage"), by undersigned counsel, hereby joins the Reply Comments filed by 8x8, Inc. ("8x8"), Lightyear Network Solutions, LLC ("Lightyear"), VoicePulse Inc. ("VoicePulse") (together, the "Commenters") with the Department of Telecommunications and Energy ("Department"), and desires to be associated with that filing.

Like the Commenters, Vonage is a provider of interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services. As noted in the above-referenced Reply Comments, consumer protection and service quality obligations imposed on monopoly providers of telephone service must be carefully evaluated before imposing similar requirements on VoIP providers. VoIP providers operate in a competitive marketplace and technological differences make certain practices (such as "slamming") irrelevant in the VoIP context. Further, given the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") open docket relating to VoIP services, Vonage joins the Commenters in strongly recommending that the Department defer any further consideration of these matters at least until the FCC concludes its ongoing proceeding.
