## Commercial Horseshoe Crab Bait Fishery Trip Limit to Remain at 300 Crabs

DMF's commercial horseshoe crab regulations include a fishery performance-based trigger to increase the limited entry bait fishery trip limit from 300 to 400 horseshoe crabs effective August 1 if more than 50% of the annual quota is projected to remain after July 31. As of today, dealer-reported landings used for quota monitoring show that less than 50% of the annual quota remains. Accordingly, **the horseshoe crab bait fishery trip limit will remain at 300 horseshoe crabs.**
