Massachusetts Hate Crimes, 2012

Executive Summary

Bias Motivation

In 2012 prejudice against race/ethnicity or national origin was the most widely reported bias motivation, representing 50.5% of the total (down from 50.7% the year before). Bias against sexual orientation is the second most frequent bias motivation, with 31.9% of the total (up from 25.7% in 2011). Religious bias was third with 15.9% (down from 20.9% the year before).

Bias crimes entail a variety of different criminal offenses, ranging from violent crimes to vandalism. Of the 551 criminal offenses reported in 2012, the most frequent offense was harassment (28.9%, down from 29.9% in 2011). General civil rights violations were second (26.1%, down from 28.1% the year before) with vandalism/property damage the third most frequently reported offense (19.6%, up from 17.7% in 2011). There were 44 aggravated assaults reported, the exact number reported the year before.

Victims and Offenders

Echoing previous years, males were still the most frequent victims (70.1%, up from 64.4% in 2011) and offenders (80.4%, up from 76.2% in 2011) of hate crimes. Females were victims in 29.9% of incidents (down from 34.9% in 2011). Females as a percentage of offenders were 19.6% (down from 23.8% in 2011). (For a breakdown of victims and offenders by gender, please refer to Tables 15 and 17.) Whites were also the most frequent racial category as victims (48.9%, up from 48.5% in 2011), and also as offenders (69.1%, up from 41.8% the previous year). Black victims of both genders composed 29.9% of the total victim population, down from 38.1% the previous year. Black offenders comprised 21.3% of offenders, up from 20.2% the previous year. Victims were reported to have some type of injury in 21.2% of cases, up from 19.8% of cases in 2011. (Please refer to Table 18 in the Appendix: Injury Types.)

Location

Bias incidents reported by police in Massachusetts occur in a variety of locations, both public and private. In 2012, 29.6% of incidents occurred in a residence, down from 32.2% in 2011. An additional 24.1% occurred on a highway or street, down from 25.5% in 2011. The third most frequent location was schools and colleges at 8.1%, down from 10.7% in 2011, while another 7.8 % of incidents occurred at unknown locations, down from 9.6% in 2011. Targets

Individuals and private property were primarily the targets for bias crimes in the Commonwealth, with 87.5% of the reports, down from 87.9% the previous year. Government buildings were the second most-frequent target in 2012 with 4.3% of the reports, up from 2.4% the year before. Police cited businesses, in 2.9% of the incidents, as the third most frequently targeted location, down from 5% the previous year. (Please refer to Table 11 in the Appendix: Targets of Bias Crimes).

Notes on Data

The 2012 Hate Crime report for Massachusetts was compiled using data voluntarily supplied from police departments across the Commonwealth. The Commonwealth Fusion Center's Crime Reporting Unit received a total of 345 reports of incidents of hate crime (unchanged from 345 in 2011) from 68 municipal police departments and 9 campus police agencies. An additional 263 municipal police departments, 27 campus police agencies, the Environmental Police, and a specialized agency reported zero hate crimes during 2012. The 345 incidents encompassed 353 bias types and 551 criminal charges (down from 358 bias types in 2011, a decrease of 1.4%; and down from 598 criminal charges in 2011, a decrease of 7.9%). After receipt and state data quality check, the CRU submits all Massachusetts hate crime data to the FBI for further analysis and inclusion in their annual *Hate Crime Statistics* publication.

Hate crimes are reported as 'incidents.' Many of these reports have multiple victims, multiple offenders, multiple offenses, and multiple bias motivations. In addition, some reports are submitted with missing data. As a result of these issues, the totals in the following tables may not be the same.

Definitions

<i>Hate Crime</i>	Any criminal act to which a bias motive is evident as a contributing factor. The Reporting Act covers bias on account of race, religion, ethnicity, handicap, gender, or sexual orientation. Hate crimes can be reported only by law enforcement agencies.
<i>Zero Report</i>	An official report by a police department stating no hate crimes were reported to the department during the reporting period.
<i>Non-reporting agencies</i>	Local police departments, and other law enforcement agencies, which are not in compliance with the provisions of the Reporting Act. These agencies failed to indicate how many, if any, bias crimes occurred in their jurisdiction.
<i>Reporting agencies</i>	Local police departments, as well as other law enforcement agencies, who have voluntarily reported the incidence of identified bias crimes in their jurisdiction. Agencies can comply with the Reporting Act by reporting the number of bias crimes, even if zero. Participating agencies which reported zero hate crimes for 2012 are listed separately.

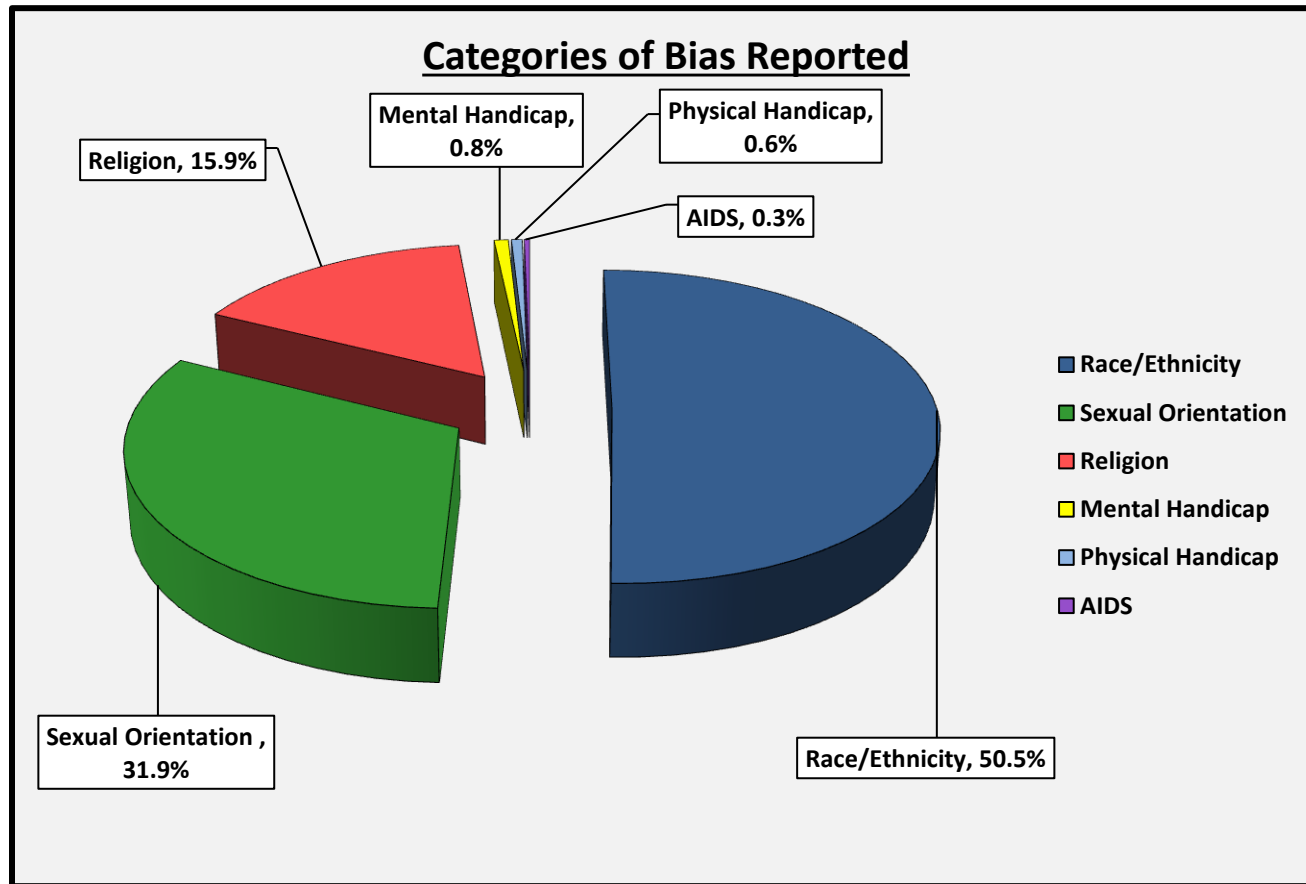
Reports by Law Enforcement Agencies

Hate crimes were reported by 68 local police departments and 9 campus police agencies. The local police departments reporting represent a total population of 2,823,854. A total of 345 hate crime reports were filed by these agencies, which included 551 criminal offenses and 353 reported bias motivations. An additional 263 municipal police departments, 27 campus police agencies, Environmental Police, and a specialized agency submitted Zero Reports for 2012. These municipalities represented a total population of 3,500,516. Fifty-five municipal agencies and 37 campus police departments did not participate in the hate crime reporting program. These agencies had a total population of 148,851.

In the statistics that follow, it should be noted that a single incident report may include multiple offenses, bias motivations, victims or offenders. As a result, totals in some categories may exceed the number of reports. Similarly, some reports omit information in certain categories, resulting in totals lower than the number of incident reports collected.

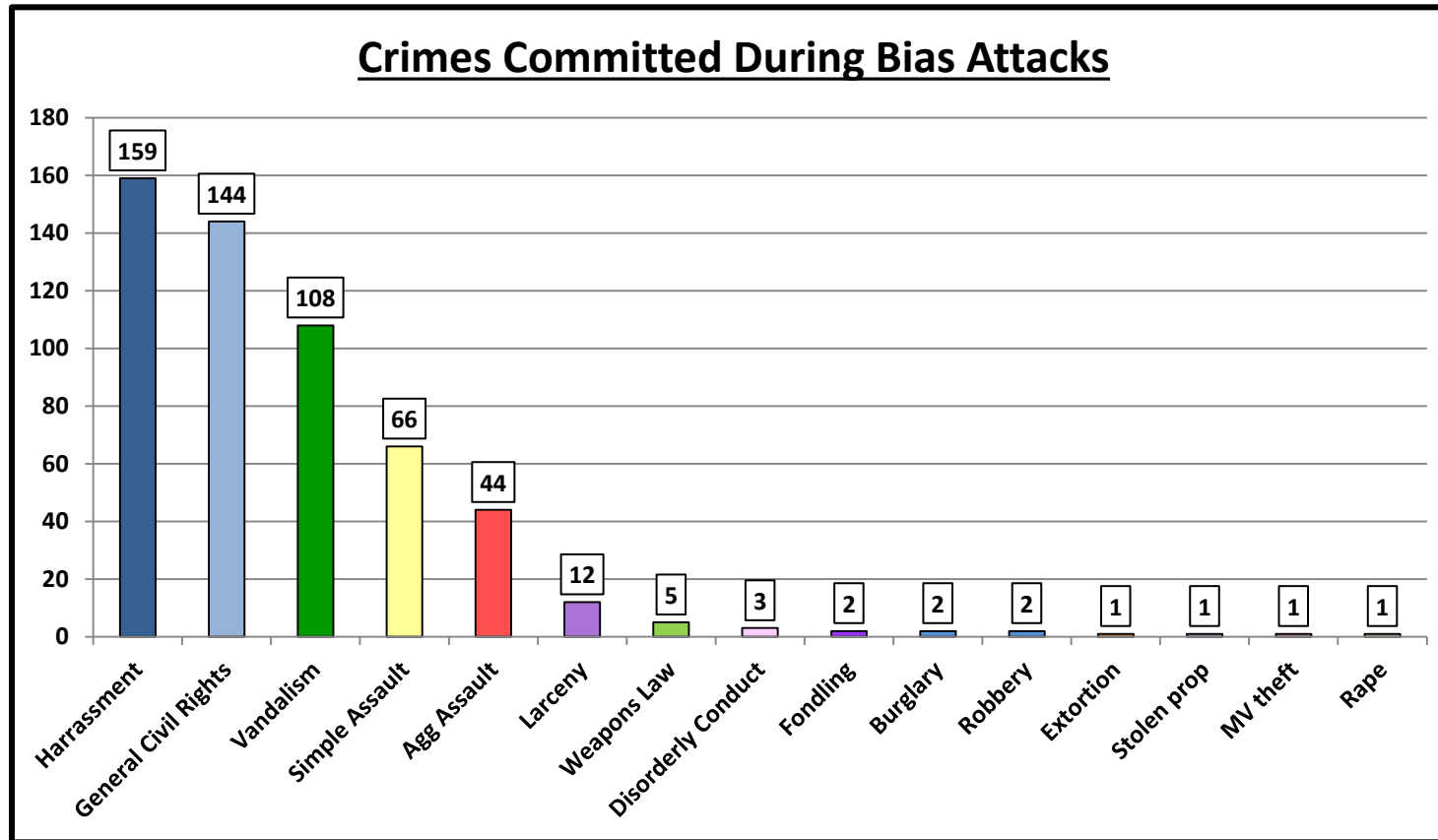
Categories of Bias Reported

Bias motivations break down as follows: of the 353 bias motivations for particular incidents reported, race/ethnicity/national origin bias constituted the largest category of reported motives, with 50.5% of the total (down from 50.7% in 2011 and from 52.9% in 2010). Offenses motivated by sexual orientation bias were the second most frequent category, with 31.9% of the total (up from 25.7% in 2011 and from 26.6% in 2010). Offenses related to religious affiliation were the third most prevalent, with 15.9% (down from 20.9% in 2011), while anti-mental handicap offenses were 0.8% of the total (zero were reported in 2011); physical handicap was 0.6% of the total (down from 1.1% in 2011), and against AIDS status was 0.3% of the total (unchanged from 2011).



Categories of Crimes Reported

Of the 551 total crimes reported, Harassment / Threats were the most frequently reported offense, representing 28.9% of the total (down from 29.9% in 2011). For the third year in a row, General Civil Rights Violations were the second most frequently reported offense, with 26.1% (down from 28.1% in 2011). Vandalism / Damage to Property were the third most frequently reported offenses, representing 19.6% (up from 17.7% in 2011). Other frequently reported offenses were Simple Assault (12.0%, up from 11.2% in 2011) and Aggravated Assault (8.0%, up from 7.4% in 2011).

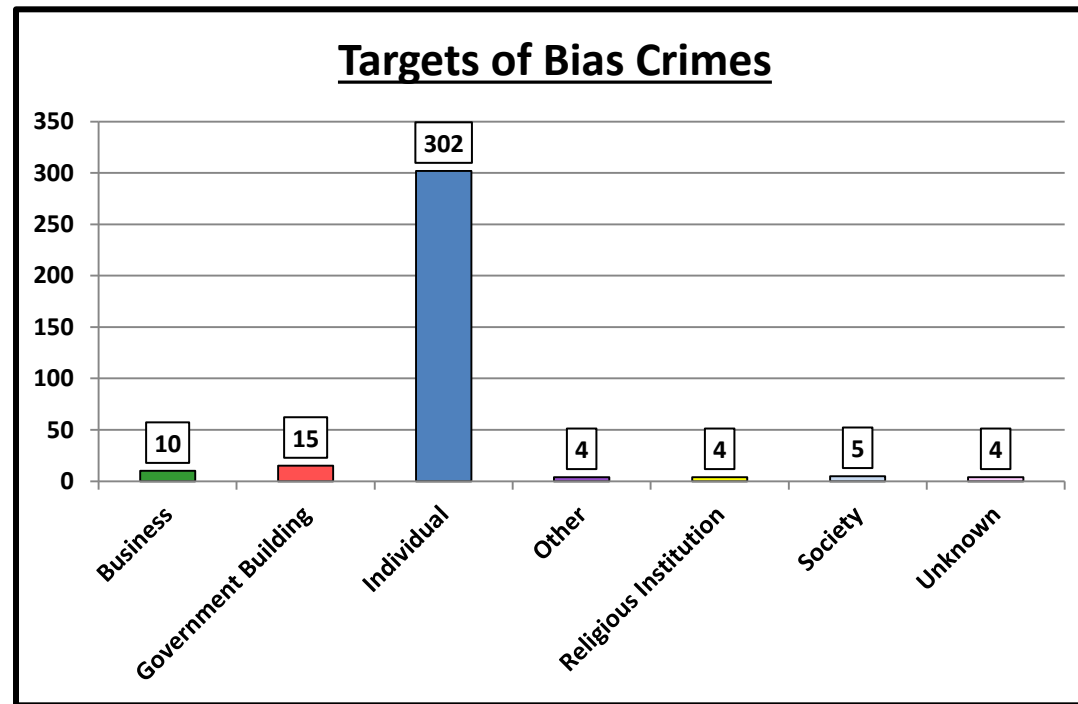


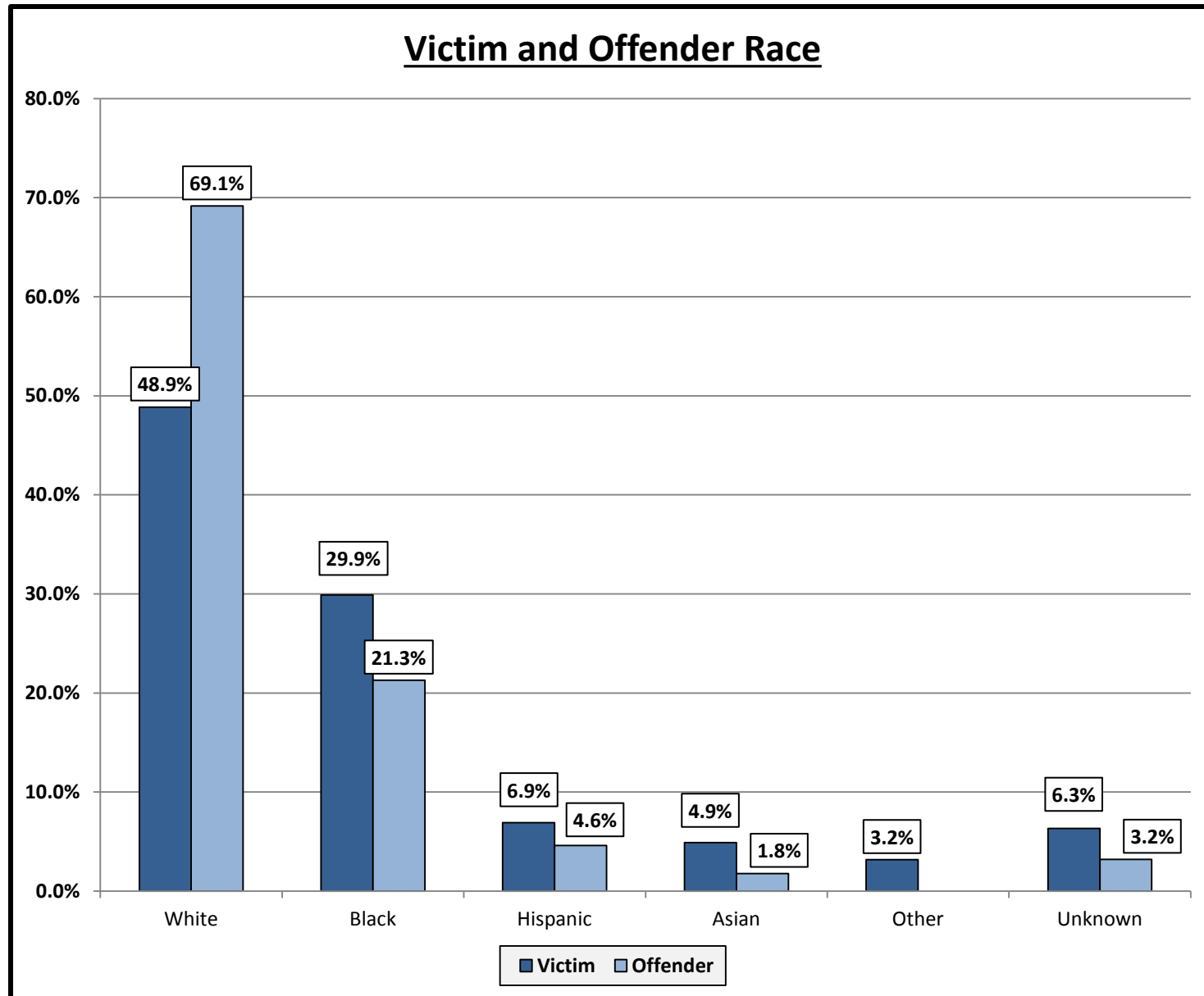
Victim and Offender Profile

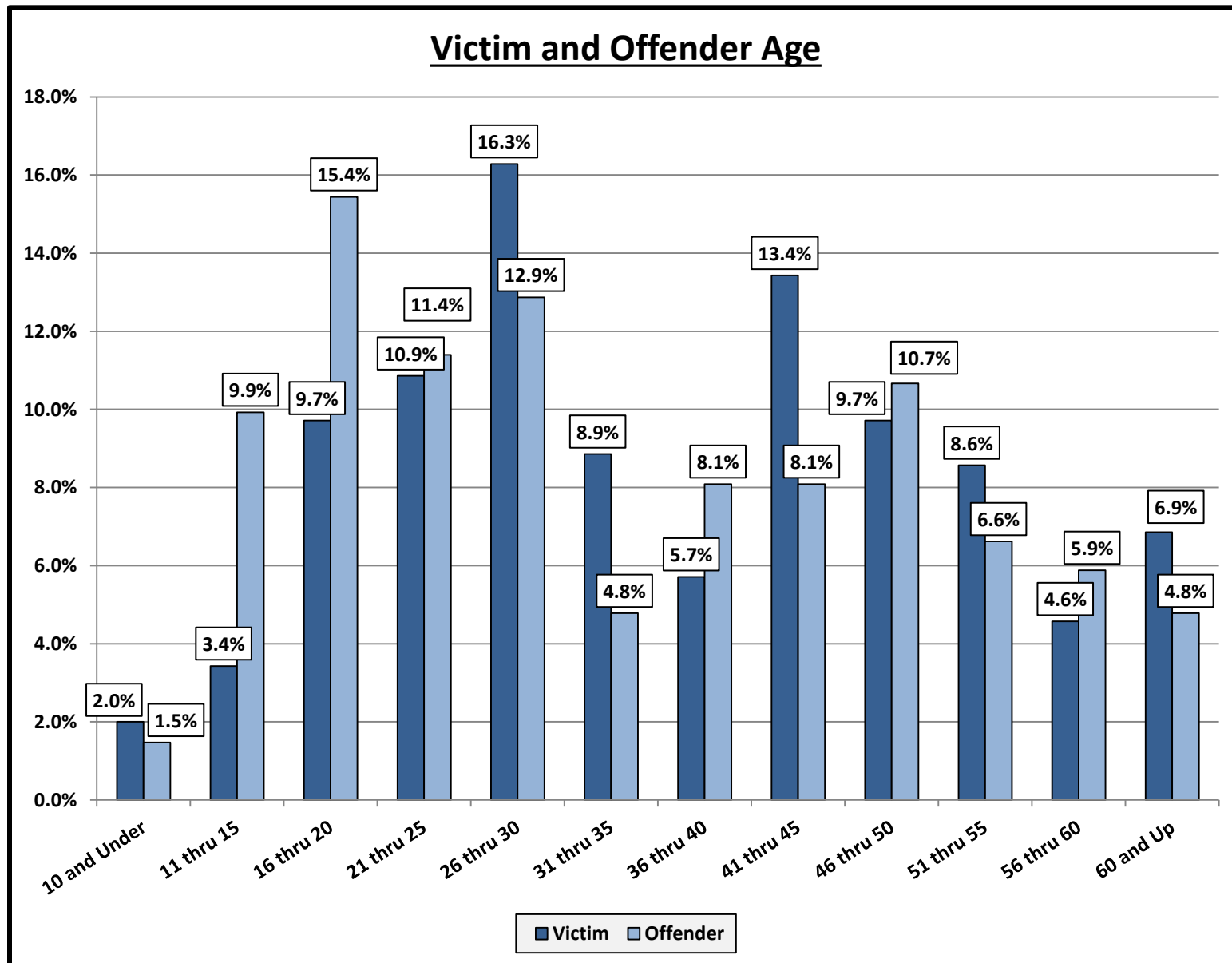
Of the cases with valid information, a “Person” (including private property) was the target in 87.5% of cases (down from 87.9% in 2011). “Government buildings” were second, with 4.3% (up from 2.4% in 2011). “Businesses” were the third most frequently targeted group, with 2.9% of the incidents (down from 5% in 2011). “Unknown” targets were fourth, with 1.5% (up from 0.6% in 2011); followed by “Society” with 1.4% (up from 1.2% the previous year); “Religious Institutions” at 1.2% (down from 1.5% the previous year), and “Other Targets” at 1.2% (unchanged from 2011).

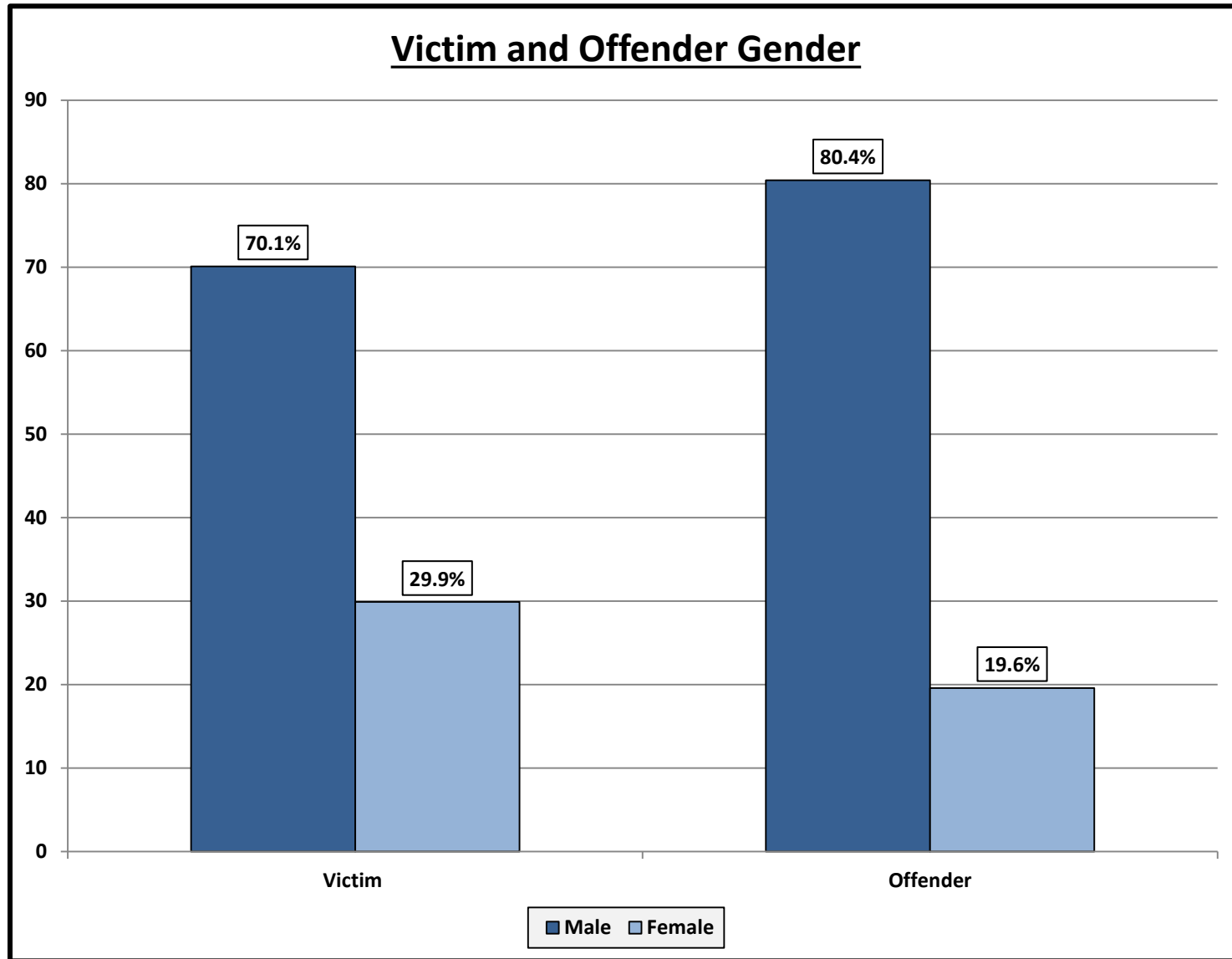
In incidents where the victim’s race was reported, whites were victims 48.9% of the time (up from 48.5% in 2011), while blacks were victims in 29.9% of cases (down from 38.1% in 2011). The victims were male in 70.1% of cases (up from 64.4% in 2011). Unlike in other years, in the cases where the victim(s)’s age group was identified, the most frequently reported age group was 26-30 years of age.

The perpetrator(s) of hate crimes were white in 69.1% of cases (up from 41.8% in 2011*), and black in 21.3% of cases (up from 20.2% in 2011*), in the 381 cases where this information was identified. The perpetrator was male in 80.4% of cases (up from 76.2% in 2011), and of the cases where the offender(s)’s age group was identified, the most frequently reported age group was 16-20 years of age, the same as the previous year.









Characteristics of the Incidents

The majority of incidents occurred in residences (29.6%, down from 32.2% in 2011); followed by highways or streets (24.1%, down from 25.5% in 2011). Other locations where incidents occurred, in descending order, were schools/colleges (8.1%, down from 10.7% in 2011); unknown locations (7.8%, down from 9.6% in 2011); parking lots/garages (6.1%, up from 2.3% in 2011); commercial office buildings (4.9%, up from 3.2% in 2011); specialty stores (3.5%); restaurants (2.9%); and the locations field/woods and government/public were both 2.0% each (field/woods unchanged from 2011; government/public up from 1.7% the previous year).

Weapons of some type were used in 172 incidents. In cases where the type of weapon was identified, hands/fist/feet were used the most frequently (22.3%, down from 46.8% in 2011). “Other weapons” were listed in 6.4% of cases (down from 28.8% in 2011); knives or cutting instruments were used in 4.9% of cases (down from 8.6% in 2011); blunt objects were used in 4.1% of cases (down from 10.1% in 2011); “unknown weapons” used in 1.7% of cases; firearms in 0.3%; and asphyxiation in 0.3% of cases.

Of the 240 incidents in which injury information was submitted, no visible injuries were reported in 189 (78.8%) of the incidents. Other minor injuries were reported in 47 incidents (19.6%); two incidents of broken bones (0.8%); and two incidents of severe lacerations (0.8%) were reported.

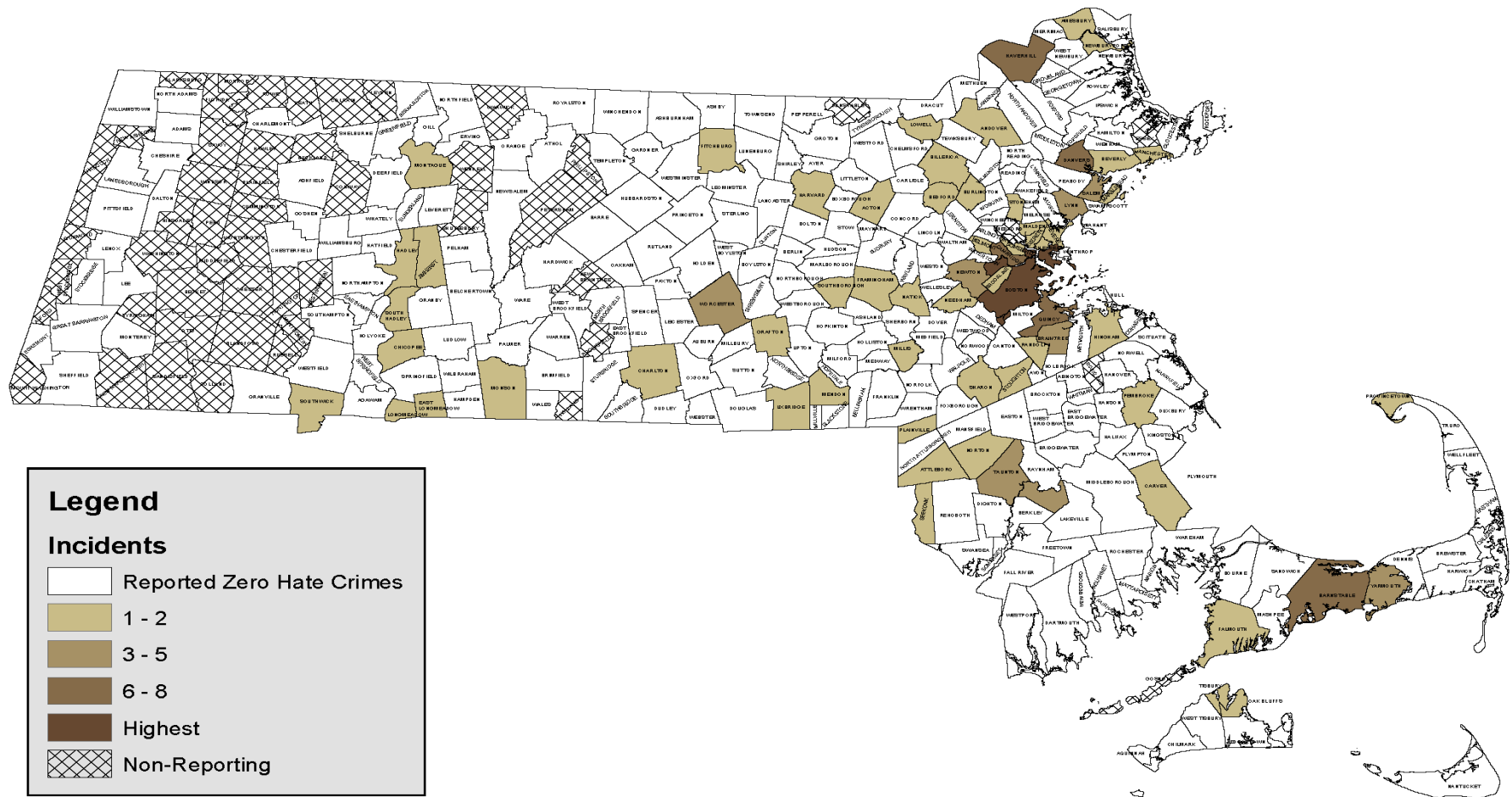
