#### SECTION 8301 JURISDICTION

8301.1 Electrical Code. The "Electrical Code" in Massachusetts is 527 CMR 12 but building structure protection and fire-resistance requirements are found in Section 8302 below.

#### SECTION 8302 BUILDING STRUCTURE PROTECTION

**8302.1 Drillling and notching.** Wood-framed structural members shall not be drilled, notched or altered in any manner except as provided in Chapters 55 through 58, of this code and as applicable.

**8302.2 Penetrations of fire-resistance-rated assemblies.** Electrical installations in hollow spaces, vertical shafts, and ventilation or air-handling ducts shall be made so that the possible spread of fire or products of combustion will not be substantially increased. Electrical penetrations through fire-resistance-rated walls, partitions, floors or ceilings shall be protected b approved methods to maintain the fire-resistance rating of the element penetrated. Penetrations of fire-resistance-rated walls shall be limited as specified in Section 5317.3.

**8302.3 Penetrations of firestops and draftstops.** Penetrations through fire blocking and draftstopping shall be protected in an approved manner to maintain the integrity of the element penetrated.
