Editor's Note:

"The Division of Inspectors within the Department of Public Safety shall have sole authority to administer the powers, duties and regulations of the abolished State Building Code Commission..."

The State Building Code Commission was abolished by Section 273 of Chapter 351 of the Acts of 1982. Executive Order 203 states:
