October 1, 2018

7D Training Changes

 New applicants must successfully complete two hours of pre-service training before applying for a 7D certificate.

7D Vehicle Changes

- All tires must have a minimum tread depth of 4/32".
- All vehicles need additional safety equipment:
 - Body fluid clean up kit
 - Seat belt cutter
 - o Fire/evacuation blanket for wheelchair vehicles only
- Both sides of all 7D vehicles must have company name, city, and state visibly displayed.

October 1, 2019

7D Training Changes

• Eight hours of in-service training must be completed for all 7D renewal applicants.

7D Vehicle Changes

- All vehicles must have an interior school bus light indicator.
- All vehicles must have an audible backup alarm.

October 1, 2020

7D Vehicle Changes

- All vehicles must have a child reminder system.
- Size of vehicle can not exceed seating capacity for 10 passengers.
