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Anglers Urged to Use Caution as Hurricane Erin Passes Offshore

DMF urges shore-based anglers fishing from locations like rocks, beaches, piers, and jetties to use caution and be vigilant of high surf conditions as Hurricane Erin passes east of New England. Even though the storm is forecast to pass offshore of the region, conditions may change quickly over the next 48 hours. Areas that are usually safe to fish from can become unsafe due to storm surge, high surf, and onshore winds. Additionally, boaters should monitor the latest marine forecasts and advisories prior to leaving port.
