The Honorable Select Boards for the following coastal municipalities: Falmouth and Gosnold

Ladies & Gentlemen,

In accordance with Chapter 130, Section 74A of Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has determined that additional portions of Buzzards Bay including shellfish growing areas E1 and E4.1 in the towns of Gosnold and Falmouth, no longer meet the established criteria for a status of "Open to Shellfishing" due to combined sewer overflow (CSO) discharges associated with heavy rainfall on August 26 and 27, 2024. Shellfish growing areas BB7, BB10, BB11, BB12, BB14, BB16, BB18-BB19 and BB21-BB23 in the towns of Dartmouth, Fairhaven, Mattapoisett and the city of New Bedford, closed on August 27th due to CSO discharges, were also impacted by the additional CSO discharges and remain under an emergency closure. The status of E1 and E4.1 shall be changed to "Closed to Shellfishing" effective at 12:00 noon on 8/28/2024 until further notification is made by the Division of Marine Fisheries.

Under the authority of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 130, Section 74A, the status of the areas identified below shall be changed to "Closed to Shellfishing" Digging, harvesting or collecting and/or attempting to dig, harvest or collect shellfish, and the possession of shellfish from the below areas is prohibited until further notice.

Under authority of 322 CMR 7.01 (7) all permits issued thereunder are hereby conditioned to prohibit the taking, selling or possession of shellfish from the areas listed below.

STATUS: CLOSED TO THE TAKING OF ALL SHELLFISH AS LISTED BELOW

The waters, flats and all tributaries of that portion of Buzzards Bay within the following Shellfish Growing Areas and municipalities: E1, and E4.1 in the towns of Gosnold and Falmouth.

Individual shellfish growing area definition boundaries are mapped on the Division's website at Shellfish classification areas | Mass.gov.

These shellfish growing areas shall remain in the "Closed to Shellfishing" status until examined by the Division and notification is made that the areas have been placed in the open status.
