INTERIM TRIP LIMIT

LONGFIN SQUID FISHERY

Pursuant to the notice and public comment requirements of G.L. c.30A, §3 and under the authority of G.L. c.130, §17A and 322 CMR §§ 6.39(2) and 7.01(7) the Director of the Division of Marine Fisheries hereby declares a 2,500 lb incidental longfin squid trip limit effective 0001 hours on August 11, 2014 through 2359 hours on August 31, 2014. During this period, it shall be unlawful for any commercial fisherman, permitted in accordance with G.L. c.130, §§ 2 and 80 and 322 CMR § 7.01(2), to possess or land more than 2,500 pounds of squid in the waters under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth. This incidental trip limit shall expire on September 1, 2014.
