Ladies & Gentlemen:

In accordance with Chapter 130, Section 74A of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has determined that a portion of the West Branch of the Westport River, the Judy Island Relay Area (BB3.27), no longer meets the established criteria for a status of "Open to Shellfishing" due to the transplant of contaminated quahogs from the Taunton River (Permit #188320). The status of this area will **be "Closed to Shellfishing" as of 12:00 noon on Friday, August 8, 2025.**

Therefore, the Division of Marine Fisheries has changed the status of the below defined area to "Closed to Shellfishing" to prohibit the taking of shellfish until subsequent determination by this office reveals that the shellfish are safe for human consumption.

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 130, Section 74A, 75, and 322 CMR 7.01 (7), digging, harvesting, or collecting and/or attempting to dig, harvest, collect or the possession of shellfish from the below defined area is prohibited.

BB3.27 Judy Island

"The waters and flats of that portion of the West Branch east of a line drawn from the "NO SHELLFIISHING" sign at the point of land north of the Judy Island to the "NO SHELLFISHING" buoy south of Judy Island and continuing to the "NO SHELLFISHING: sign on the eastern shoreline approximately halfway between Judy Island and Grasshopper Point."
