In accordance with Chapter 130, section 74A of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has determined that below-defined shellfish areas, in the Town of Barnstable, no longer meet the requirements for an open status following an extremely heavy rain event on August 8, 2023.

Therefore, under authority of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 130, sections 74A, **effective at 12:30 pm on August 8, 2023**, the below-defined areas have been placed in a "**CLOSED TO SHELLFISHING**" status to the taking of all shellfish except carnivorous snails. Digging, harvesting or collecting and/or attempting to dig, harvest or collect shellfish and the possession of shellfish from the below-defined areas is prohibited.

Under authority of 322 CMR 7.01(7) all permits issued thereunder are hereby conditioned to prohibit the taking, selling or possession of shellfish from the below-defined areas.


