

DIRECTOR'S DECLARATION: 2020 WINTER II COMMERCIAL SCUP LIMITS

Pursuant to the notice and public comment requirements of G.L. c.30A, §3 and under the authority of G.L. c.130, §17A and 80, and 322 CMR §§ 6.27(2)(e), 6.41(2)(d) and 7.01(7), the Director of the Division of Marine Fisheries with the approval of the Marine Fisheries Advisory Commission, hereby declares:

- 1. During the period beginning at 0001 hours on October 1, 2020 until 2359 hours on December 31, 2020, or until 100% of the 8,394,299-pound 2020 Winter II commercial scup quota allocation is taken, commercial fishermen who hold a commercial scup regulated fishery permit endorsement may retain, possess and land up to 24,000 pounds of scup per trip or calendar day, whichever period is longer.
- 2. This action to set the 2020 Winter II scup possession and landing limits does not exempt the permit holder from any superseding state or federal regulations governing scup possession limits during the Winter II period for vessels fishing with nets that have less than 5-inches mesh applied throughout the codend of the net.
