

IMPARTIAL UNIT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

CHECKS

I. Appeal fee of \$450.00 made payable to the Department of Industrial Accidents

Only one check is accepted for the full \$450.00 appeal fee. If a second party appeals thereafter, that appellant's check in the amount of \$450.00 must be sent to the DIA in order to perfect the appeal. The second check is returned and the second appellant is required to send a check for \$225.00 to the party that paid the \$450.00 appeal fee. The fee is due within 10 days from filing the appeal.

II. Supplemental Report fee of \$125.00 made payable to the Department of Industrial Accidents

Only one check is accepted for the full \$125.00 fee. If both parties request the supplemental report, the parties should split the fee and agree as to which party will send the \$125.00 check to the DIA.

III. Second Examination (IPR) fee of \$450.00 made payable to the examining practitioner and sent to the Department of Industrial Accidents.

Parties may agree to split this fee and send separate checks.

IV. No Show fee of \$100.00 made payable to the Department of Industrial Accidents

Reschedule of an Impartial Examination will not take place until the fee is received. No show fee is incurred if cancellation is not requested within 48 hours of the scheduled examination.

V. Deposition fee made payable to the physician and sent directly to the physician.

\$700.00 for first 2 hours, \$150.00 for each additional hour, up to 2 hours. Fee is paid by deposing party.
