DECISION

JULIE'S ENTERPRISES, LLC DBA JULIE'S PLACE
208A MAIN STREET
ACTON, MA 01720
LICENSE#: 000600042
HEARING HELD: NOVEMBER 15, 2011

Julie's Enterprises, LLC dba Julie's Place (the "Licensee") holds an all-alcoholic beverages license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 15, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report dated July 28, 2011; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On July 28, 2011, at approximately 1:58 p.m., Commission Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the licensed premises operating as a restaurant, Julie's Enterprises, LLC dba Julie's Place.
2. An underage operative, working with the Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser beer, for three dollars and seventy-two cents (\$3.72). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
