Subject: ADA Amendments Act of 2008

Purpose: To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators

and other local workforce investment partners of the enactment of amendments to

the Americans with Disability Act of 1990.

Background: On Thursday, September 25, 2008, President George W. Bush signed into law:

S.3406, the "ADA Amendments Act of 2008," which clarifies and broadens the definition of disability and expands the population eligible for protections under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. The Act is intended to restore congressional intent with regard to the application of a broad interpretation of conditions that "substantially limit" one or more major life activities of an individual in determining if the individual is covered by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. The amendments were enacted in response to a series of Supreme Court decisions that Congress believed too narrowly defined the parameters of coverage and severely restricted, against Congressional intent, an individual's ability to seek redress for discriminatory practices under the Act.
