Dear Mr. Fee:

By letter dated August 9, 2012, the Board of Registration of Pharmacy (Board) informed you of its preliminary denial of your application for registration as a Pharmacy Technician and of your right to request an opportunity for a hearing on such preliminary denial within 21 days of the August 9th letter. You did not submit a timely request for hearing and have therefore waived any right to such hearing.

Based on the documentation and other information upon which the Board based its preliminarily denial of your application, as set forth in the Board's August 9, 2012 letter, and as you have not contested the basis for such preliminary denial, the Board informs you of its **Final Decision** to deny your application for Pharmacy Technician registration.
