#### **Partnership to Expand Housing Opportunities (PEHO) Round II & Gateway Cities Revitalization Programs**

- 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE REQUEST FOR PEHO ROUND II TO JANUARY 31:** DHCD is extending the deadline for requests for technical assistance in drafting a Request for Proposals (RFP) for mixed-income redevelopment of state-funded public housing to **January 31, 2020**. DHCD is moving this date to conform with the new application deadline for PEHO II proposals of April 15, 2020, as posted in Addendum #5 on November 25, 2019. This gives LHAs interested in applying one final opportunity to receive limited technical assistance funding to draft a RFP.

Applicants who need assistance in evaluating the appropriateness of their development for this program, in preparing the developer RFP, or evaluating the responses thereto, may request initial technical assistance by emailing Paul McPartland ([paul.mcpartland@mass.gov](mailto:paul.mcpartland@mass.gov)) by **January 31, 2020**, including a description of the technical assistance needed and the reasons why it is required in order to complete the application process.
