Coding Updates for Certain Durable Medical Equipment, Oxygen and Respiratory Therapy Equipment

Summary

In accordance with [101 CMR 322.01\(6\)](#): *Coding Updates and Corrections*, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) is adding new procedure codes and updating narratives for certain codes, effective for dates of service on or after [April 1, 2026](#), and [July 1, 2026](#). The following lists specify codes that have been added and code descriptions that have been revised.

For entirely new codes with associated Medicare fees, payment rates are set at a percentage of prevailing Medicare fees as described in 101 CMR 322.03(16)(a). For entirely new codes without associated Medicare fees, individual consideration (IC) is applied to establish payment as described in 101 CMR 322.03(16)(b). For existing codes for which only the description has changed, the rates are unchanged as described in 101 CMR 322.01(6)(b). Rates listed in this administrative bulletin are applicable until revised rates are issued by EOHHS.

The appearance of a code in the following tables does not constitute authorization for, or approval of, the procedures for which rates are determined pursuant to 101 CMR 322.00. Governmental units that purchase care are responsible for the definition, authorization, and approval of care to publicly aided individuals.
