Statewide Airport Administration Building Program

- Three buildings completed Group 1, three buildings underway – Group 2 (Plymouth Municipal Airport – approximately 35% complete, North Adams – beginning construction and Norwood under Final Design)
- All buildings are scheduled to be substantially complete by the end of State FY2019
- The statewide program won a 2018 award for "Regional Excellence in Wood Design" from the Woodworks – Wood Products Council. 'Wood was chosen as a unifying element, designed to marry sustainability with the structural and visual considerations'

Security Awareness Workshop



- The Beverly Regional Airport hosted a Security Awareness Workshop on October 31, 2018
- The purpose of the workshop was to discuss current threats to critical infrastructure, types of suspicious activity to report, who to call under the 'See Something, Say Something' campaign and the lessons that can be learned from real life security incidents at airports
- Presenters included the FBI, TSA, State Police & MassDOT Aeronautics Staff
- Approximately 40 Attendees including:
 - Federal and State TSA, FBI, US DOT, FEMA, State Police, and MassDOT AD
 - First Responders Police and Fire from Beverly, Danvers, and Wenham
 - Municipal Beverly City Council, Danvers Selectman, Beverly Airport Commission, and Airport Personnel
 - Tenants North Shore Aero Club, North Atlantic Aviation, Cat Aviation, etc.

Brigham and Women's Hospital Helipad

- 'State of the Art' BWH Helipad officially opened on October 17, 2018
 - Advanced glycol deicing system
 - LED lighting system
 - In support of \$1B Expansion of Boston Children's Hospital
 - Built to support Coast Guard Helicopters
 - Approximate cost was \$20M in private investment
 - Aeronautics inspected and provided input to BWH Helipad operators
- Supports Emergency Transport Operations
 - Over 500 medical landings per year
 - Supports both BWH and BCH (30% landings)
