6. Old business (The Board may or may not discuss):
 - 10-11 Arlington Street – Boston, MA - The petitioner was in front of the Board on June 16, 2020 seeking a product variance to install an automated parking device. Product name: Lifting Table FAU-40411378 [Scissor Lift].
 - Discussion regarding escalator sterilizer systems.
 - 174 Ipswich Street, Boston – The petitioner was in front of the Board on May 5, 2020 seeking a variance from ASME A18.1-2014 Section 2.1.1.1, to allow a 36” high guard at the upper landing. Placed on hold for 90 days.
 - 55 Fruit Street, Boston, MA – The petitioner’s representatives were in front of the Board on May 12, 2020 seeking a variance to install PurHealth Escalator and Moving Walkway Handrail Disinfecting Systems at the above location. Placed on hold for 90 days for the applicant to revise the submission.
 - Discussion regarding 524 CMR 35:00 Section 2.8.3.3 – Sprinklers shall not be permitted in power passenger or freight elevator hoistways, pits, machine rooms or control spaces – consideration of other types of systems.
 - Discussion regarding the adoption of the 2016 elevator code.
 - Discussion regarding new Controller/Fire Service.
