 - a. *Neonicotinoids*: Update on MDAR efforts with implementing the action to change the classification of products containing neonicotinoids that have specific use patterns from general use to state restricted use.
 - b. *Glyphosate:* (1) Inform the Subcommittee about the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals order to EPA to re-examine cancer risks of glyphosate; (2) Update on the Glyphosate Commission activities to conduct a scientific review of the potential impacts of glyphosate and its most common alternative herbicides on the environment and public health.
