Voting will be by open roll call and the candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be declared elected.

Please note that while registration for the Conservation District meeting is required to obtain the Zoom access information, you may register at any point prior to or during any meeting. There is no requirement to register in advance of any meeting to attend; registration and access to each meeting is available both prior to and during each meeting until it has ended.
