## What we have been working on since May



- Continued Advancing new Preferred Throat Alternative
  - MassDOT selection of Highway At-Grade "Modified" Hybrid (Soldiers Field Road over I-90 EB) and continued development of Concept Design including Construction Staging
- Conducted NEPA DEIS meetings with FHWA and Cooperating Agencies
- NEPA One Federal Decision process officially started with the publication of the NOI on 10/18
- Continued Coordination with MBTA and Harvard University on West Station Flip
- Continued advancing supplemental CTPS analysis
- Continued Conducting Subsurface Investigations in BPY and developed plan for additional investigations for Soldiers Field Road Viaduct and Temporary Soldiers Field Road Structure

- Conducted July and August Metrowest and Central Massachusetts Public Information Meetings on;
  - Project Background including Project Timeline
  - Alternatives Under Consideration

## What we have been working on since May – cont.

  - Franklin Street footbridge is an important, neighborhood connector
  - Cambridge Street at Linden Street and Lincoln Street
  - Cambridge Street at Seattle Street
  - Along the Dudley
    White Path
  - At the BU Bridge





## **FHWA NEPA Actions and Update**



- In May FHWA determined an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is the appropriate COA for the project
- Notice of Intent (NOI) filed in the Federal Register on October 18, 2019
- NEPA process from NOI to Record of Decision (ROD) expected to take approximately 2 years
- Invitation to state and federal agencies to become Participating and Cooperating Agencies on the project sent in July
- First agency meeting to introduce the project held on July 16<sup>th</sup>
- Subsequent agency meetings held on August 27<sup>th</sup> and October 9<sup>th</sup>



## **Executive Order 13807: One Federal Decision**



- Requires One Federal Decision (OFD) process for NEPA Authorizations for Major Infrastructure Projects:
  - One lead Federal agency is responsible for navigating each major infrastructure project through the entire Federal environmental review and permitting process.
- Establishes Collaboration for Environmental Reviews
  - Federal agencies have a goal of completing the NEPA Process within two years.
  - Federal permits issued within 90 days of the Record of Decision.
- Public Tracking of all Environmental Impact Statement and Environmental Assessment projects, regardless of OFD applicability





# Implementing OFD (4/9/2018 OMB MOU)



- MOU Implementing OFD Under EO 13807 establishes concurrence points for Cooperating Agencies
- Pre-NOI (Phase I)
  - Concurrence Point #1 Written Concurrence on Purpose & Need and Permit Timetable
- NOI to DEIS (Phase II)
  - Concurrence Point #2 Alternatives to be carried forward for analysis in the DEIS
  - Concurrence Point #3 Determination of Preferred Alternative
- Agencies must concur within 10 days of the request for concurrence



## **Permitting Actions and Update**



- Meeting with Army Corp (USACOE) on September 13<sup>th</sup> to discuss General Permit Process
- On going coordination meetings with DCR, DEP, MEPA
- The Project Initiation Request was accepted by the United States Coast Guard (USCG) marking the start of Temporary Bridge Permitting Process
- USGS Preliminary Navigation Review Determination is being processed



## FHWA NEPA Scoping Process



- Public's first chance to comment on the project during the NEPA process
- Scoping document describes
  - Project Purpose and Need
  - Alternatives and Alternative Screening and Analysis
  - Methodology for analyzing each alternative during NEPA Environmental Review
  - Opportunities for Agency Coordination and Public Involvement
- Scoping Public Information Meeting will be on November 7
- Comment Period Ends December 12, 2019
