Reporting:

- (ii) an evaluation of all state-funded efforts in Alzheimer's disease research, clinical care, institutional, home-based and community-based programs;
- (iii) the outcomes of such efforts; and
- (iv) any proposed updates to the state plan, which the advisory council shall annually review.
