The Office of the Inspector General prepared this report to estimate public agency spending on construction projects within the commonwealth. I hope that this report will assist the legislature and public officials to better understand where construction dollars are potentially being spent.

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## **Purpose**

The Office of the Inspector General reviewed and analyzed construction project data for a five year period (January 2000 to December 2004). In light of the legislature's enactment of construction reform legislation, this office anticipates that this data will be useful to state agencies, municipalities, and others to identify what types of projects account for capital expenditures. This is intended to be a reference tool.

## **The Central Register**

Much of the data analyzed in this report comes from the Central Register. The Central Register is a weekly publication produced by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. The Central Register includes bidding information for state, county and municipal design and construction contracts. Building construction projects, as opposed to horizontal (roadway) construction projects, which require the procurement of design services must be advertised in the Central Register if the final estimated cost is \$100,000 or more. Other construction, maintenance or demolition projects or the purchase of construction supplies valued at \$10,000 or more must be advertised as well. Jurisdictions must submit project information to the Central Register on specific forms (See Appendix A).

## **Methodology**

The Secretary of State's office provided this office with detailed information concerning contracts advertised in the Central Register for calendar years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004. Additionally, the Division of Capital Asset Management provided this office

with information regarding the Division's capital construction project contract awards for the same time period.

This office categorized each contract award by type of work and by type of structure. For example, a contract that involved repairs on a town hall would have been categorized as *Maintenance* (type of work) and *Town/City Hall* (type of structure). Construction of a new high school would have been categorized as *New Construction* (type of work) and *School – Primary or Secondary* (type of structure). Tables One and Two present and a brief description for each of the categories used in this classification.

This report presents the construction project data in several ways. First, the report gives information on the frequency and value of types of work and structures by presenting the top five categories in each and providing a brief description of the projects in each category. This report then presents information for the most frequent and highest value type and structure categories for state and municipal contracts. Finally, this report contains data tables with complete information for each category in Appendix B.

The Central Register published 4,154 contract awards during the review period of January 2000 to December 2004. This office refined the data from the Central Register to include only unique construction contract awards with a total dollar value listed for the award amount. As a result, the analysis did not include 591 contracts that had no total contract dollar value and 92 real property contracts. Subsequent to the initial release of this report in December 2005, we received supplementary information from the Division of Capital Asset Management concerning the total number of construction contracts awarded by the Division and the dollar value for those contracts. Therefore this office then replaced any Division projects in the Central Register data with the construction contract data provided directly by the Division. The resulting dataset included 3,392 construction contract awards totaling \$3,526,202,324.

### Construction Contract Awards by Structure Category

The top five structure categories in the Central Register are Housing (905 contracts), School – Primary or Secondary (370 contracts), Other Structure (367 contracts), Sewer Infrastructure (305 contracts), and Road (239 contracts).

In terms of dollar value, the top five structure categories are School – Primary or Secondary (\$753,013,157), Sewer Infrastructure (\$506,203,583), Housing (\$395,986,177), Other Structure (\$354,448,160), and School – Higher Education (\$343,412,319).

### *School – Primary or Secondary Projects*

Public schools represent a significant number of the construction contracts awarded during this time period. As stated earlier, School – Primary or Secondary represents the highest total dollar value and the second largest number of construction contracts awarded. Of the 3,392 awards examined by this office, 370 (10.9%) were School – Primary or Secondary projects. Out of the 370 school projects, renovation projects occurred most frequently, representing 127 (34.3%) contracts. Other types of projects within School – Primary or Secondary include roofing projects, which represent 40 (10.8%) of the contracts awarded; design services, 30 contracts (8.1%); maintenance, 30 contracts (8.1%); and HVAC, 23 contracts (6.2%).

Additionally, during the time period examined, 14 new school construction contracts were listed in the Central Register. These 14 contracts represent 3.8% of the total number of primary or secondary school contracts. The total value of these contracts is \$208,533,190. This represents 27.7% of the total dollar valuation of School – Primary or Secondary contracts.

The City of Springfield and the City of Boston each awarded 35 School – Primary or Secondary construction contracts during this time period. These 70 contracts represent 18.9% of all primary or secondary school projects (9.5% respectively). The City of Boston awarded 14 maintenance contracts, with another seven for renovations. The City of Springfield awarded eight contracts for design services, with another seven for roofing and five for renovations. The Town of Andover awarded another 24 (6.5%) school construction projects; 12 being renovation contracts. Needham and Newton rounded out the top five municipalities with 20 (5.4%) and 19 (5.1%) of the school projects respectively. Newton awarded ten construction contracts for renovations, while Needham awarded six for renovations and four for design services.

### *Housing Projects*

Construction projects at facilities owned by housing authorities appear most often in the Central Register. Of the 3,392 contracts, 905 (26.7%) are categorized as Housing. Renovation projects occurred most frequently. Of the 905 housing projects, 250 (27.6%) contracts were for renovations. Other significant types of projects included roofing projects (106 or 11.7%), maintenance (79 or 8.7%), fire/security systems (68 or 7.5%) and painting (60 or 6.6%).

### *Sewer Infrastructure Projects*

Sewer infrastructure construction contracts represented the third highest number of contracts with the second highest total dollar value. Sewer projects accounted for 305 (9.2%) of the total 3,392 projects. Of the 305 sewer infrastructure projects, 179 (59.7%) were categorized as renovation projects. 58 (19.0%) were new construction and 33 (10.8%) were maintenance contracts.

### Construction Contract Awards by Type of Work Category

The top five type of work categories in the Central Register are Renovations (1,147 contracts), Maintenance (373 contracts), Roofing (225 contracts), New Construction (208 contracts) and Miscellaneous (197 contracts).

In terms of dollar value, the top five descriptions are Renovations (\$1,591,330,139), New Construction (\$1,167,651,221), Miscellaneous (\$174,551,966), Maintenance (\$122,345,779) and Roofing (\$60,223,755).

### *Renovations Projects*

Of the 3,392 construction projects, 1,147 (33.8%) were renovation projects. Of the 1,147 renovation projects, 250 (21.8%) were housing projects. Sewer infrastructure renovation accounted for 179 (15.6%) projects while road renovation work accounted for 136 (11.9%) projects. Primary and secondary schools represented 127 (11.1%) renovation projects while there were 78 (6.8%) renovation projects on other structures.

### *Maintenance Projects*

Maintenance projects represent 373 (11.0%) of the 3,392 total contracts awarded during the period examined in this report. Housing maintenance projects represented 79 (21.2%) of the maintenance projects. Road maintenance accounted for 55 (14.7%) projects, while there were 51 (13.7%) maintenance projects on other structures.



## Construction Contract Awards by Government Entity

The top government entity category in the Central Register is Town/City (2,410), this is followed by State with 846 construction contracts, Other (52), School District (43), and County (41) (this includes county-level purchasing agents that were formed or that remained after the legislature abolished certain county-level governments). State construction contracts are the top government entity category in terms of dollar amount with \$1,675,469,103. Town/City construction contracts follow with \$1,657,790,483 then School District (\$152,427,156), Other (\$35,619,454), and County (\$4,896,128).

### *Municipal Contracts*

The City of Boston's construction contract awards total \$265,110,157 and number 335, each ranking first among contract awards by a municipality. The City of Springfield represents the next highest total dollar value of construction contracts with \$155,238,925. Springfield's 140 contracts also represent the second highest number of construction contracts awarded by a municipality. The City of Cambridge's 86 contract awards total \$93,366,774 and represent the fourth largest number and third largest value of construction contracts awarded by a municipality. The City of Newton awarded 124 construction contracts, third amongst municipalities. These contract awards total \$45,512,406, seventh amongst municipalities. The town of Franklin has the fifth highest number of construction contract awards (73), while ranking sixth (\$62,019,778) in value of contract awards. The City of Worcester and Town of Andover represent the fourth and fifth greatest value of construction contract awards with \$73,814,194 and \$67,839,675 respectively. The Town of Andover awarded 64 contracts while the City of Worcester awarded 40 contracts, ranking sixth and ninth amongst number of municipal contract awards.

### *State Contracts*

At the state agency level, the Division of Capital Asset Management awarded construction projects with the greatest total dollar value (\$715,314,066). The 166 contracts that the Division awarded represented the second largest number of construction contracts awarded by state agencies. Most often the Division awarded contracts for renovations (74 projects totaling \$34,226,616). New construction represented 47 projects (\$335,357,949), and roofing represented 11 projects (\$6,598,151).

The Massachusetts Water Resources Authority awarded the second highest dollar value of construction contracts, totaling \$468,787,122. The Water Resources Authority's 57 contracts represent the fourth most contracts awarded by a state agency. The Water Resources Authority awarded 16 contracts for renovation projects (\$34,226,616), 10 for consulting service projects (\$3,992,506), eight for new construction projects (\$391,180,565), and seven for maintenance projects (\$3,704,036).

The Massachusetts Port Authority awarded the largest number of construction contracts (297), which represents the third highest total dollar value of contracts (\$266,665,900). Most often the Port Authority awarded contracts for renovations (85 projects totaling \$79,461,915). Maintenance projects represented 82 contracts (\$37,251,578), and miscellaneous projects represented 40 contracts (\$40,603,789).

The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority awarded the fourth greatest dollar value of construction contracts, totaling \$130,931,661. This represents 21 contract awards, the eighth most amongst state agencies. The Authority awarded eight renovation projects (\$60,929,449) and eight miscellaneous projects (\$56,223,572).

The Department of Mental Health awarded the third highest number of construction contracts (97), totaling \$7,772,172, eighth overall in total dollar value among state agencies. The Department awarded 29 renovation projects valued at \$2,527,560 followed by 17 fire/security system projects totaling 1,331,508 and 12 elevator projects totaling \$862,286.
