J. Chen & Ruie Family Corp. d/b/a Mootone Fine Japanese Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 13, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Doyle's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report;
- 2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact; and
- 3. Copy of Licensee's License Application.

## <u>FACTS</u>

- 1. On Thursday, May 2, 2019, at approximately 6:18 p.m., Investigators Bailey and Doyle ("Investigators") investigated the business of J. Chen & Ruie Family Corp. d/b/a Mootone Fine Japanese Restaurant.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Bud Light beer for four dollars and sixty-five cents (\$4.65). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2014 with no prior violations.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)-Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
