## **DECISION**

OM PATEL, INC. DBA RICHDALE SUPERETTE 10 RAILROAD ST ANDOVER, MA 01810 LICENSE#: 002600040 HEARD: 06/05/2012

Om Patel, Inc. dba Richdale Superette (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 5, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kenny's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following exhibits are in evidence:

- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
- A. TIPS Training Certificates for Licensee and Employees;

- C. Photos of Posted Signs, Re: ID Needed for Alcohol Sales at Licensed Premises.

## **FACTS**

- On Monday, April 2, 2012, at approximately 6:28 p.m., Investigators Tim Hooton and Mark Kenny conducted an investigation of the business operation of Om Patel, Inc. dba Richdale Superette.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a can of Budweiser beer, for two dollars and twenty-nine cents (\$2.29). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
