- 1. "Consistent with M.G.L. c. 30, § 62K." What is section 62K? Can't find it in M.G.L.
- 2. Definitions: I don't see the definition of Environmental Justice in M.G.L. c. 30, § 62. Since there are several different definitions EJ (federal, state, informal), please include the definition you want used directly in this list of Definitions. This definitions is made even more problematic since the EOEEA Mass. EJ online map viewer includes so many conflicting layers (income at 150% and 65% of state household income, etc.).
- 3. "MEPA review provides opportunities for meaningful public involvement by impacted communities, persons and organizations, including Environmental Justice Populations, in Agency decision-making, and promotes information gathering and analysis to reduce the potential for unfair or inequitable effects upon Environmental Justice Populations." Add red insert.
- 4. If you really want "meaningful" opportunities for public involvement, you must give examples. Meaningful to some is a meeting with the public. Meaningful involvement really is a chance to not just change the size of the windows, but to stop a bad project or design.
