Instructions to Retirement Systems & Pension Funds

(Henceforth called Systems)

- (1) **Date of Filing:** The statement is required by law to be filed on or before May 1st.
- (2) **The Name of the System** must be typed or stamped at the top of all pages and schedules (and duplicate schedules), and on all inserted schedules and loose sheets.
- (3) This statement must be typewritten or prepared legibly using electronic media.
- (4) Blank Schedules will not be accepted. If no entries are to be made, type "NONE" across the schedule in question.
- (5) Each category of investment must be grouped alphabetically on appropriate schedules as listed below. Group totals in each category must be shown (sub-totals should be identified as such). Investments must be listed on a trade date basis (as opposed to the cashbook, which is on a settlement date basis). Purchases made prior to January 1st, but not settled until after December 31st, should be recorded as accounts payable and, as such, should be listed as purchased and owned. Sales made prior to January 1st, but not settled until after December 31st, should be listed as sold and no longer owned. *
