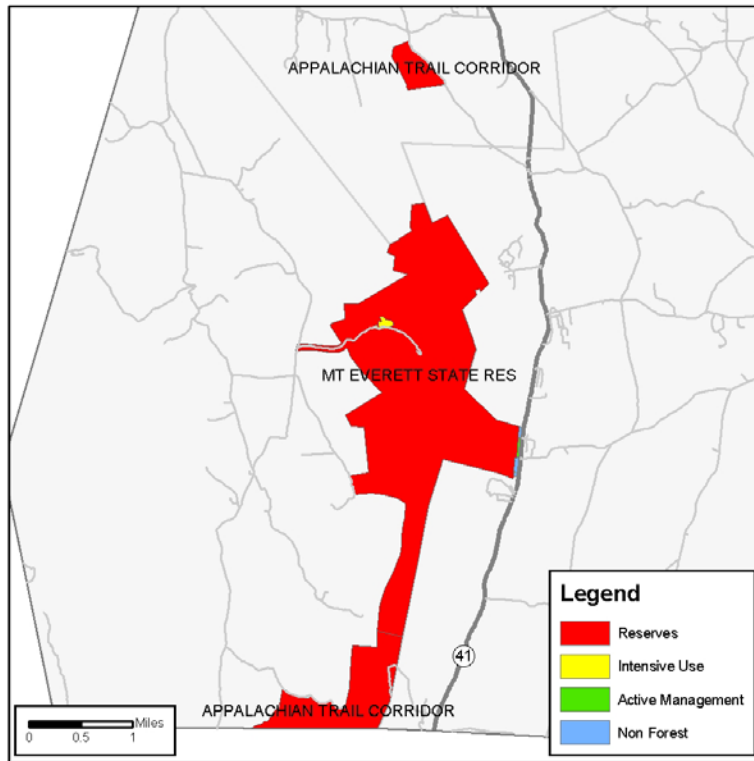


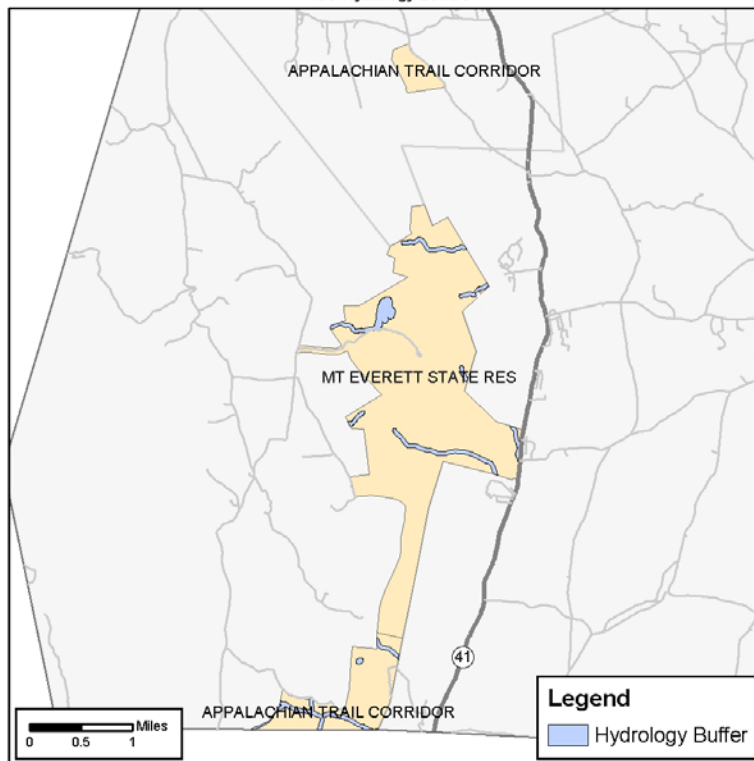

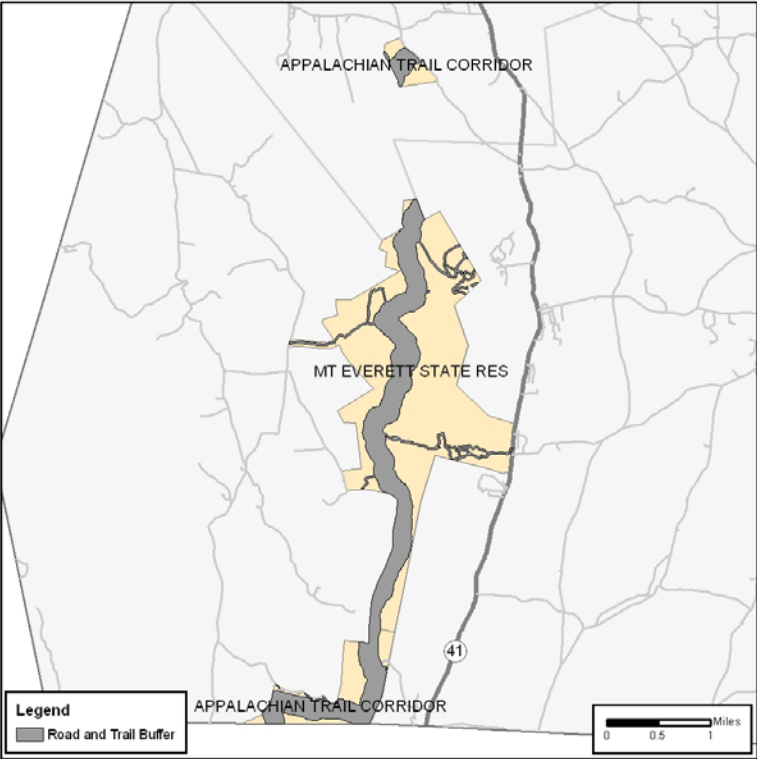

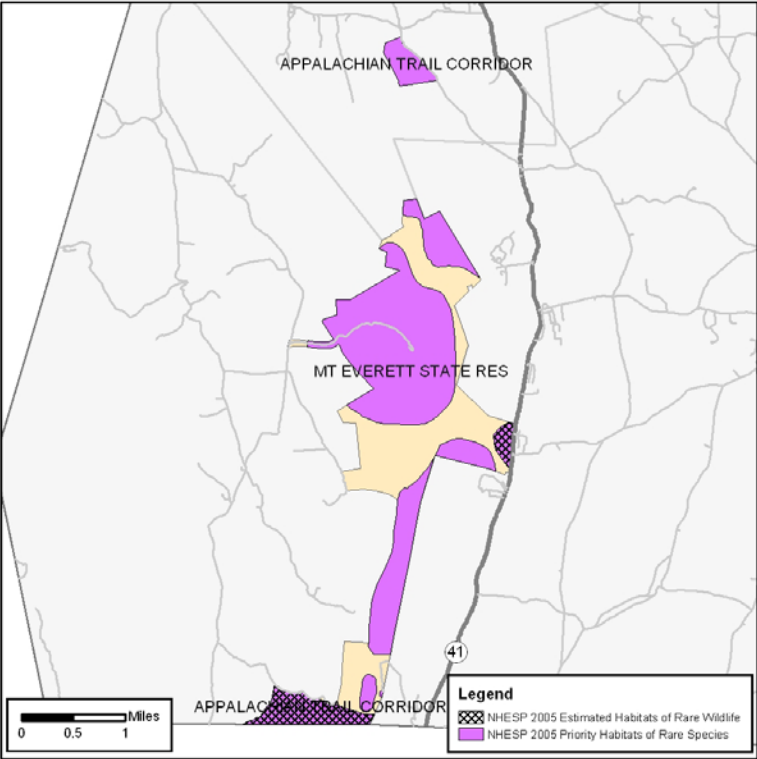

100' Hydrology Buffers



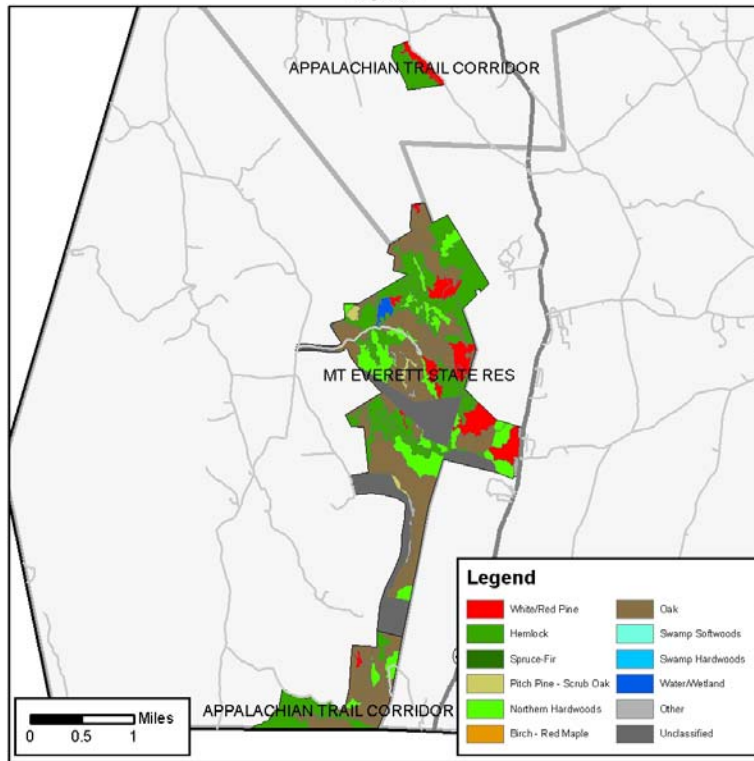

50' Road and Trail Buffers (500' Appalachian Trail)



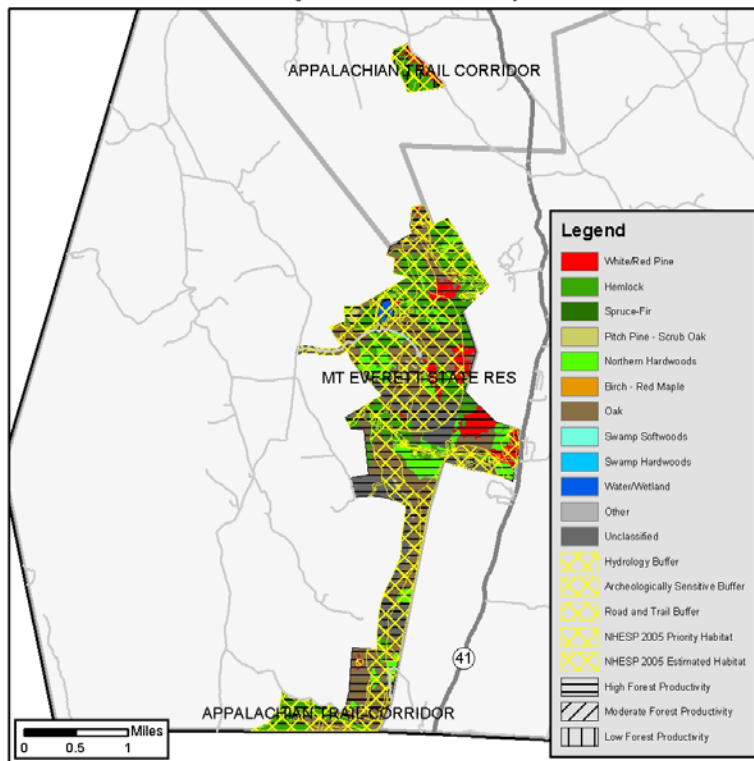

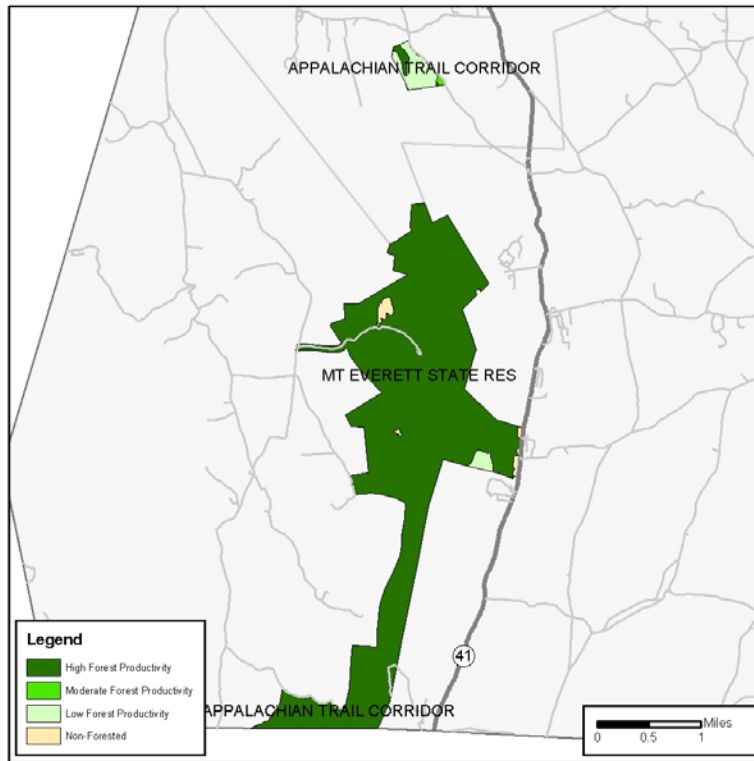
