## APPEAL DECISION

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involved a delay in the start date of the appellant's long-term care coverage due to a disqualifying transfer of resources. The record was held open after hearing for the appellant's representatives to provide documentation to verify the transactions that MassHealth had counted as transfers, and for MassHealth to review that documentation. After review of the appellant's submission, the MassHealth worker assigned to the case (different from the worker who appeared at hearing) reported that all but \$2,365.75 of the transfer had been cured. The appellant's representatives reported that they would concede that portion of the transfer.

As the issue on appeal has been resolved to the appellant's satisfaction, this appeal is dismissed.
