



Procedural Background

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal was MassHealth's November 2, 2021 denial of the appellant's June 2021 application for long-term-care benefits due to excess assets. Exhibit 2. The appellant timely appealed on December 9, 2021. Exhibit 2; 130 CMR 610.015(B); EOM 21-17 (Oct. 2021).

Following the hearing, the record was left open until March 18, 2022 for the appellant to submit proof of asset reduction. MassHealth agreed to continue processing the appellant's June 2021 application. Exhibit 5.

As no issue on appeal remains in dispute, this matter is DISMISSED pursuant to 130 CMR 610.051(B).
