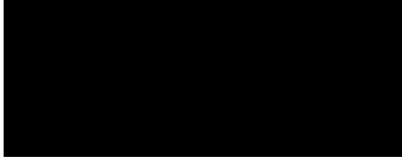

## APPEAL DECISION

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involved a denial of the appellant's long-term care application for excess assets. The record was held open after hearing (and the record-open period subsequently extended) for the appellant's representative to submit documentation that a conservator had been appointed and, as such, that the appellant's assets were temporarily inaccessible. After documentation of the appointment was submitted to MassHealth, the MassHealth case worker reported that the appellant had been approved for coverage pending a review of the assets in November 2022.

As the issue in dispute has been resolved, the appeal is dismissed.
