## Authority

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

#### Jurisdiction

Through notice dated February 25, 2022, MassHealth notified the appellant that she is eligible for MassHealth Senior Buy In coverage effective March 1, 2022 (Exhibit 1). The appellant timely appealed this notice, and the hearing was scheduled for April 14, 2022 (Exhibits 1 and 2). At hearing, the MassHealth representative explained that after updating the appellant's case, her MassHealth Standard and Senior Buy In coverage is active and there has been no gap in her coverage since 2013. The appellant stated that she is aware of her active benefits and has no issue or dispute with her coverage. She clarified that she filed the appeal because she wants MassHealth to approve authorization of dental implants.

Because MassHealth has taken an action that has resolved all eligibility issues related to the February 25 notice, this appeal is appropriately dismissed (130 CMR 610.035(A)(8)).<sup>1</sup>
