This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involved more countable assets than MassHealth benefits allow. At the request of the appellant's conservator, the hearing record was left open to provide documentation that the appellant had reduced her assets to qualify for MassHealth benefits.

On May 16, 2023, the MassHealth representative reported that she had received the necessary evidence that the appellant's assets had been reduced and the member was approved for long-term care benefits effective 5/1/2022.

As the issue of excess assets has been resolved, the appeal is dismissed.
