Authority

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

Jurisdiction

Through a notice dated October 11, 2022, the nursing facility, Brentwood Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center, issued an Expedited Notice of Intent Discharge with Less than 30 Days' Notice because the safety of individuals at the nursing facility was endangered due to appellant's clinical or behavioral status (Exhibit 1). The appellant filed this appeal in a timely manner on October 12, 2022 (see 130 CMR 610.015(B) and Exhibit 2). Challenging a nursing home discharge is valid grounds for appeal (see 130 CMR 610.032).

At hearing the nursing facility testified that it would rescind its Notice of Intent to Discharge with Less than 30 Days' Notice. The appellant left the room before withdrawing from the appeal. As the issue in this case has been resolved, this appeal is DISMISSED.
