

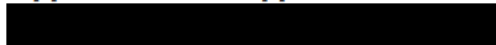

## APPEAL DECISION

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involved a denial of the appellant's long-term care application for excess assets. The record was held open after hearing for the appellant's representative to submit documentation of the spend-down. At the close of the record-open period, the MassHealth representative reported that MassHealth had received the necessary documentation and would issue a new eligibility determination using the application date of August 31, 2022.

As the issue of excess assets has been resolved, the appeal is dismissed.
