Authority

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

Jurisdiction

Through a notice dated December 16, 2022, MassHealth modified the Appellant's prior authorization (PA) request from the requested 7 hours and 45 minutes per week of day/evening personal care attendant (PCA) services to 6 hours and 45 minutes per week of day/evening PCA services. (Exhibit 1). The Appellant filed this appeal in a timely manner on December 30, 2022. (See, 130 CMR 610.015(B) and Exhibit 2). At the hearing, the parties agreed to the following modifications of the Appellant's request for PCA services for the prior authorization period at issue (December 16, 2022 to December 15, 2023):

- 1. <u>Mobility/physical assist</u> to school bus: Denied, Appellant understands and agrees that this is a parental responsibility;
- 2. <u>Grooming/nail care</u>: Denied, Appellant understands and agrees this is a parental responsibility;
- 3. <u>Grooming/oral care</u>: Approved at 2 minutes, twice per day, 7 days a week;
- 4. Grooming/hair: Approved at 1 minute, once per day, 7 days a week;
- 5. <u>Dressing</u>: Approved at 5 minutes, once per day, 7 days a week; and
- 6. <u>Undressing</u>: The parties agreed to 3 minutes, once per day, 7 days a week.

Because the above-captioned modifications were agreed upon and resolved at the hearing, there are no longer any issues in dispute. Therefore, this appeal is dismissed. (130 CMR 610.035(A)(8)).
