This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. At hearing the appellants' representative indicated that her mother received a notice from MassHealth that she will begin receiving MassHealth Care Plus benefits on May 1, 2023, and that she has no issues with their health coverage. The appellant's representative expressed concern about coverage for a specific medication, but it was explained that she will get a separate notice with new appeal rights for any coverage issues with a particular medication. As such, where there is no issue at appeal with respect to the relevant notice, this case is dismissed.
