This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involves MassHealth's denial of Appellant's prior authorization request for comprehensive orthodontic treatment (PA No. 202305200290900) Exhibit 1. The hearing record was held open for Appellant to submit a medical necessity narrative. Exhibit 5. Upon receiving the medical necessity narrative, the MassHealth representative determined that Appellant met the medical necessity guidelines for treatment. Exhibit 7. MassHealth overturned the denial. *Id*.

As there was an adjustment that resolves the issue in dispute between the parties, this appeal is dismissed. 130 CMR 610.035(A)(8), 130 CMR 610.051(B), 130 CMR 610.083(C).
