

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. Through a notice dated March 21, 2023, the nursing facility issued a Notice of Intent to Discharge the resident for nonpayment. See Exhibit 1. The appellant filed a timely appeal on the same date. See Exhibit 2. At hearing on April 20, 2023, the appellant and his representative indicated that they expected the appellant would soon be approved for alternative housing in the community. The record was held open after hearing for a status update on the efforts to find such housing. During the record-open period, the appellant's representative reported that the appellant had indeed secured housing and would be moving out of the facility on May 1, 2023.

As the issue on appeal has been resolved, this appeal is dismissed.
