## APPEAL DECISION

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The appellant filed an appeal of a July 3, 2023, notice denying coverage for long-term care benefits for failure to submit the proper verifications. At hearing, it became clear that the appellant was actually seeking MassHealth Standard as a community case through the Frail Elder Waiver. The appellant was a long-term resident of a nursing home from 2023, until she was discharged on 2023, and has been residing in the community ever since. A long-term care application was filed on the appellant's behalf in March of 2023, seemingly by the nursing home. Because that long-term care application was still missing verifications and had not been withdrawn, the appellant's community application was unable to be processed. During the record open period, the appellant's representatives were able to provide all outstanding verifications for the long-term care application. MassHealth was therefore able to process that application and approve the appellant with a patient paid amount.<sup>1</sup>

The MassHealth representative was also able to process the appellant's community application and approved the appellant for MassHealth Standard coverage through the Frail Elder Waiver beginning on July 20, 2023, with no gap in coverage. As the issues on appeal have resolved, the case is hereby dismissed.
