This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involves Respondent Greenfield Rehabilitation and Nursing Center's [REDACTED] 30-day notice of discharge issued to Appellant. At hearing and on record, Appellant signed a rep payee form and Respondent rescinded the [REDACTED] notice of discharge. The parties agreed that the hearing issue was resolved.
