




## APPEAL DECISION

This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The issue on appeal involved a denial of the appellant's long-term care application for excess assets. The record was held open after hearing for the MassHealth representative to review new documentation submitted prior to hearing. The MassHealth representative subsequently reported that she had received the documentation necessary to show the spend-down and would make a new eligibility determination using the original application date.

As the issue of excess assets has been resolved, the appeal is dismissed.
