This hearing was conducted pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 118E, Chapter 30A, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. At issue is a notice dated October 23, 2023, terminating the appellant's MassHealth CommonHealth benefits due to the appellant having past due premiums. At hearing, the appellant agreed to a payment plan to resolve her past due premium balance, and MassHealth's Premium Billing department was able to reinstate the appellant's CommonHealth benefits. The appellant expressed an understanding that she must pay the past due premium balance.

As the issue on appeal has resolved, the case is hereby DISMISSED.
