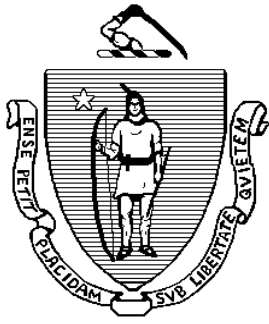

APPLICATION FOR A PUBLIC ENTITY TO TRANSFER NET METERING CAPACITY TO A PUBLIC COOPERATIVE PURSUANT TO G.L. c. 164, § 139(h)

Pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 139(h), a Municipality or Other Governmental Entity member of a Public Cooperative may transfer some or all of its unsubscribed net metering capacity to the Public Cooperative, subject to the approval of the Department of Public Utilities ("Department"). As provided in G.L. c. 164, § 139(f), a Municipality or Other Governmental Entity may not exceed ten megawatts ("10 MW") of net metering capacity. Before transferring net metering capacity to a Public Cooperative, a Municipality or Other Governmental Entity, must submit this Application to the Department and receive Department approval for the Transfer.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PUBLIC ENTITY APPLICANTS:

- A. To complete the Application, answer all nine questions, review all checkboxes, sign the Application, and include Attachments.
- B. The net metering capacity specified in question 7 cannot exceed 10 MW. G.L. c. 164, § 139(f).
- C. Attachments to the Application:
 - a. A copy of the Applicant's Transfer Agreement with the Public Cooperative must be submitted with the Application.
 - b. Any other information that the Applicant considers relevant to the transfer request may be submitted with the Application.
- D. The Applicant must file the Application and Attachments as follows:

- E. After filing the Application, an Applicant will receive a Notice from the Department that the Applicant must: (1) serve upon the Clerk or Secretary of the public entity; (2) publish in a local newspaper; and (3) serve as otherwise directed by the Department. The Notice will provide at least fourteen calendar days from the date of service and publication for filing written comments.
- F. Before the Department will act on the Application, the Applicant must furnish proof to that it has served and published this Notice using a Return of Service per the Department's procedural regulations, 220 C.M.R. § 1.00 et seq., Appendix 2.
